1. Introduction

- The meeting was called to order at 7:00PM by Co-chairman Gordon Sheppard. A light lunch was served before undertaking the business of the meeting.

2. Agenda

- The agenda for the meeting was circulated and approved as presented.

3. Adoption of March 25, 2004 Meeting Minutes.

- The minutes were circulated electronically in advance of the meeting. Additional copies were available at the meeting for review. The minutes were approved as presented.

4. Correspondence

- Copies of a letter received from Mme. Carmen Comeau, and written French, was circulated to the committee members. An English translation of the letter was also circulated. It was agreed that Carey Letts would be asked to prepare a response for review by the committee.

5. Old Business

- The suggestion of tracing a load of contaminated soil from the source to the Belledune site was discussed as a topic for the next flyer. It was agreed that this would be the topic of the next flyer.
- James MacDonnell was asked to consider publishing the flyer, as opposed to using a commercial operation as for the previous flyer. The previous flyer cost approximately \$3,000 to produce. Bennett Environmental Inc. would provide the content and James would format it.
- The topic of hosting a meeting at the construction site was also discussed. It was agreed that the next meeting would be held there and that we would take a photograph for publication in local newspapers. Cleo Hache to assist with publication in Northern Light.

6. New Business

- The announcement of the availability of the groundwater and soil monitoring reports was circulated and discussed as written by Carey Letts. Two recommendations for revisions were offered and accepted by the committee for publication along with the photograph of the committee visiting the construction site.

It was suggested that those not wanting to participate in the committee any longer should advise accordingly so that replacements can be located to keep the committee active.
