1. Introduction

Correspondence: CELC Members – Francine Leger Guitard and Euclide Chiasson

Two CELC members sent notification of their withdrawal from the committee: Francine Leger Guitard and Euclide Chiasson of the Maritime Fishermen's Union. In a letter from the MFU, it was stated that the recent decision of the MFU Local 10 Executive and Wharf Representative Council to publicly oppose the building of the proposed facility by Bennett necessitated this action. General feeling from the CELC is that there was more reason than ever for the two members to remain on the committee and ensure the company hears any concerns they have. Correspondence will be sent encouraging their continued participation on the CELC.

Discussion

- It was proposed than an open invitation to attend CELC meetings be extended to regional mayors. An invitation will be drafted for review at next meeting.
- The Department of Environment and Local Government (DELG) made a presentation to the regional mayors and Local Service Districts regarding the Bennett project discussing topics such as the EIA Process, Environmental Studies, the Human Health Risk Assessment, the Current Status of EIA Conditions, the Approval Process and Timeline. The DELG has offered to discuss the same information with the CELC on October 9th. An acceptance by the CELC will be forwarded to the DELG immediately. Invitations to attend will also be extended to Belledune Mayor & Council, BREA and the former CELC reps of the Maritime Fishermen's Union.
